On behalf of Louisville Water Company, thank you for attending the meeting of our wholesale customers and regional partners earlier this month. We hope you found the information we shared beneficial. Going forward we are considering a workshop type meeting, that will allow full participation by our wholesale customers as well as our regional partners.

As previously discussed at the above meeting, the wholesale commodity charge effective July 1, 2016 will be \$1.85 per thousand gallons, plus an elevated service area surcharge of \$0.35 per thousand gallons, for a total wholesale rate of \$2.20 per thousand gallons.

We are planning to file the necessary documentation for this new rate with the Public Service Commission (PSC) over the next few weeks. The PSC has advised us in the past that we must inform you of the proposed rate increase in the format of the notice attached on the next page, although we have already provided you notice at our wholesale customer meeting March 8, 2016.

The Louisville Water Company has filed a proposed rate schedule which will increase by 2.3% the commodity rate(s) which it currently charges to West Shelby Water District for water service.

Louisville Water Company currently charges West Shelby Water District a \$175.35 monthly meter fee, a \$300.60 monthly meter fee, \$1.85 per thousand gallons, and \$0.30 elevated service area surcharge per thousand gallons, for a total rate of \$2.15 per thousand gallons.

Louisville Water Company proposes to charge West Shelby Water District a \$183.75 monthly meter fee, a \$315.00 monthly meter fee, and \$1.85 per thousand gallons, and \$0.35 elevated service area surcharge per thousand gallons, for a total rate of \$2.20 per thousand gallons, effective July 1, 2016.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Louisville Water Company. The Public Service Commission, however, may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.





Ray Larmee, Commission Chairman, called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Reading of Minutes:

Raymond made a motion to approve the minutes from the April meeting with a change being made to the sentence that reads "to include the Fairview tank painting" to read "to include painting the inside of the Fairview tank." Ben seconded the motion.

Business:

Waze Development - Kerry Magan, representing developer Lee Ethington, presented a plat of the residential development on Discovery Boulevard. Purchased Water Adjustment - Louisville Water Company (LWC) has filed for a rate increase with the Public Service Commission (PSC) increasing our wholesale rates from \$2.15 to \$2.20 per 1,000 gallons of water purchased. Raymond made a motion to approve submittal of a purchase water adjustment to PSC to reflect the LWC rate increase. Ray seconded the motion.

Hite's Report:

Hite stated that the Cheatham lawsuit has been dismissed.

Steve's Report:

Steve presented a plat of the apartment complex development at Brunerstown Road. Ben requested that the he review the **final** plat before a decision could be made to sign said plat.

LWC has finalized the hydraulics of the line extension into Shelby County along Interstate 64. They will be having a meeting Tuesday May 31st to discuss questions and concerns regarding the waterline extension.
