Dear Cole:

On behalf of Louisville Water Company, thank you for attending the meeting of our wholesale customers and regional partners earlier this month. We hope you found the information we shared beneficial. Going forward we are considering a workshop type meeting, that will allow full participation by our wholesale customers as well as our regional partners.

As previously discussed at the above meeting, the wholesale commodity charge effective July 1, 2016 will be \$1.85 per thousand gallons, plus an elevated service area surcharge of \$0.35 per thousand gallons, for a total wholesale rate of \$2.20 per thousand gallons.

We are planning to file the necessary documentation for this new rate with the Public Service Commission (PSC) over the next few weeks. The PSC has advised us in the past that we must inform you of the proposed rate increase in the format of the notice attached on the next page, although we have already provided you notice at our wholesale customer meeting March 8, 2016.

#### NOTICE

The Louisville Water Company has filed a proposed rate schedule which will increase by 2.3% the commodity rate(s) which it currently charges to North Nelson Water District for water service.

Louisville Water Company currently charges North Nelson Water District a \$300.60 monthly meter fee, a \$701.40 monthly meter fee, \$1.80 per thousand gallons, and \$0.35 elevated service area surcharge per thousand gallons, for a total rate of \$2.15 per thousand gallons.

Louisville Water Company proposes to charge North Nelson Water Company a \$315.00 monthly meter fee, a \$735.00 monthly meter fee, and \$1.85 per thousand gallons, and \$0.35 elevated service area surcharge per thousand gallons, for a total rate of \$2.20 per thousand gallons, effective July 1, 2016.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Louisville Water Company. The Public Service Commission, however, may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

Any corporation, association or person with a substantial interest in the matter may, by written request, within thirty (30) days after publication or mailing of this notice of the proposed rate changes request to intervene. Intervention may be granted beyond the thirty (30) day period for good cause shown.

# A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE NORTH NELSON WATER DISTRICT ADJUSTING WATER RATES AND CHARGES TO OFFSET THE LOUISVILLE WATER COMPANY WHOLESALE RATE INCREASE

WHEREAS, the Louisville Water Company ("LWC") is one of North Nelson Water District's ("District") wholesale water providers;

WHEREAS, on March 31, 2016, the LWC filed an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC") seeking to increase the wholesale water rate that LWC charges the District from \$2.15 to \$2.20 per 1,000 gallons and seeking to increase the monthly meter fees that LWC charges the District (See PSC Case TFS2016-00200);

WHEREAS, based upon the water purchases from LWC during the previous 12 months and the increased monthly meter fees at both master meter locations, the estimated annual increased cost to the District will be \$10,721.60;

WHEREAS, prudent financial management dictates that the District take immediate action to adjust its retail rates commensurate with LWC's wholesale rate increase; and WHEREAS, KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068 provide the legal mechanism for the District to increase its water rates commensurate with LWC's wholesale rate increase via a Purchased Water Adjustment ("PWA");

# NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF NORTH NELSON WATER DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The facts, recitals, and statements contained in the foregoing preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby affirmed and incorporated as a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The PWA factor is \$0.05 per 1,000 gallons;

Section 3. All tiers of water usage set forth in the District's existing tariff shall be increased by \$0.05 per 1,000 gallons, subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC.

Section 4. The monthly water rates to be charged to and collected from the customers and users of the water system of the District shall be as set forth in **Appendix A**, which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein by reference as a part of this Resolution. The rates and charges set forth in **Appendix A** are subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC. These monthly rates and charges shall be in effect for all water service rendered on and after July 1, 2016.

Section 5. The Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file the PWA Application, Tariff Sheet, and all other documents that may be required by the PSC.

Section 6. The Chairman, all appropriate District Staff, and the District's attorney are hereby further authorized and directed to take any and all other actions and to execute and deliver any and all other documents as may be reasonably necessary to implement the PWA.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.

Due to a rate increase from the Louisville Water Company, notice is hereby given that the North Nelson Water District has filed an application for a Purchased Water Adjustment with the Kentucky Public Service Commission for adjusting its water rates. Customer rates will increase by \$0.05 per 1,000 gallons used. The proposed change will be effective for service rendered on and after July 1, 2016.
