Whereas, the Breathitt County Water District Board did pass and approve a proposed rate increase for the Breathitt County Water District Systems at the June 15, 2016 regular monthly Board Meeting.

Whereas, the motion was made and approved by a vote of 5-5 that the Breathitt Water District Board increase the minimum bill from \$23.92 to \$24.16 and an increase per thousand after the first two thousand gallon from \$11.96 per thousand to \$12.08 per thousand to become effective for service rendered on and after July 1, 2016.

Whereas, cause for the proposed rate increase was impending the rate increase of purchased water from the City of Jackson.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Breathitt County Water Board that the proposed rate increase for the Water System will become effective for services rendered on and after July 1, 2016.

Due to a rate increase from the City of Jackson, notice is hereby given that Breathitt County Water District has filed an application for Purchased Water Adjustment with the Kentucky Public Service Commission for the purpose of adjusting its water rates. Customer rates will increase by \$0.12 per 1,000 gallons used. The proposed change will be effective for service rendered on and after July 1, 2016.
