

Pursuant to the Public Service Commission's Order dated May 1, 2017, Henderson Municipal Power & Light (Henderson) files this status report concerning the progress of negotiations between the parties to resolve a number of outstanding issues, including but not limited to the dispute at issue in this proceeding.

Henderson reports that the issues remain unresolved, but that Henderson believes resolution is still possible through continued discussion. For this reason, Henderson has no objection to Big Rivers' request for the Commission to hold this matter in abeyance for an additional thirty (30) days. Henderson's acquiescence in this request is subject to previously expressed objections to Big Rivers' application, including but not limited to the jurisdictional issue. In the event the Commission grants the request, Henderson agrees to file a second status report on or about August 20, 2017.
