RESPONSE TO INFORMAL CONFERENCE MEMO
OF NOVEMBER 16, 2016

Comes the Wood Creek Water District and its Individual Commissioners, Glenn Williams, Earl Bailey, and Jimmy Keller, by and through Counsel, and respond to the Informal Conference Memo of November 16, 2016 which was dated November 18, 2016.

The Wood Creek Water District and its Individual Commissioners, Glenn Williams, Earl Bailey, and Jimmy Keller, state that their actions which are the subject matter of the Show Cause Order were not willful or intentional acts; these actions were taken in an effort to realize a savings to the customers of Wood Creek in reliance on the advice of their Bond Counsel and the financial advisory group Raymond James & Associates. Bond Counsel, Randy Jones of Rubin & Hays explained during the informal phone conference of November 16, 2016 the circumstances which caused the inadvertent mistake of the Wood Creek Water District to obtain the further approval from the Public Service Commission for the additional refinancing. We understand the need of the Public Service Commission to require compliance with its Regulations even in this situation. But, the Commissioners of the Wood Creek Water District, in reliance on experts, thought they had complied with all laws and regulations. However, understanding the position of the Public Service Commission, the Wood Creek Water District and its Individual Commissioners, Glenn Williams, Earl Bailey, and Jimmy Keller, suggests a total aggregate fine of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00). Wood Creek Water District will also have a procedure in

place as a part of our review process, prior to any issuance of securities, to be certain that any approvals by the Public Service Commission has been obtained. If this proposal is accepted, the Wood Creek Water District and its Individual Commissioners, Glenn Williams, Earl Bailey, and Jimmy Keller, waive their right to a hearing.
