Comes now Nolin Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Nolin RECC"), by counsel, and hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") to convert the above-styled case from an electronic filing procedure case, (807 KAR 5:001 Section 8), to a traditional filing procedure case, (807 KAR 5:001 Section 7) and to amend the case style accordingly. As grounds for said motion, Nolin RECC respectfully states as follows:

On October 28, 2016, Nolin RECC filed a notice of intent to file a rate case and an election to use the electronic filing procedures set forth in 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8, which provides for an electronic version to be filed using the Commission's E-Filing System and one paper copy to be filed with the Commission.

However, complying with the Commission's recent Order to file six paper copies along with the electronic copy and the original paper copy will be more expensive and time consuming for Nolin RECC than simply using the traditional paper-based filing procedures established in 807 KAR 5:001 Section 7.

WHEREFORE, Nolin RECC respectfully moves the Commission to convert this case from an electronic filing procedures case to a traditional paper-based filing procedures case and to amend the case style accordingly.
