LG&E NEWS SHEET FOR Feb. 2017.

IN IT, LG&E MENTIONS THEIR REQUEST FOR A RATE
INCREASE, SPECIFICALLY AN INCREASE OF THE BASIC SERVICE
Fee OF +104.6% VERSUS AN INCREASE IN THE COST OF KWH
by 11.6% FROM \$0.086 TO \$0.096

LG&E's proposal to increase the
BSC from \$10.75 a month to \$22 a month, combined with lowering
the cents per kilowatt-hour (kWh) energy charge from \$0.086 to
\$0.084 - rather than leaving the BSC at \$10.75 a month and raising
the cents per kWh energy charge to \$0.096
