### PUBLIC NOTICE SOUTH ANDERSON WATER DISTRICT PURCHASED WATER ADJUSTMENT

Due to an increase in the wholesale rate for water purchased from the Frankfort Plant Board, the South Anderson Water District has applied to the Kentucky Public Service Commission for a rate increase to cover its increased costs. The rates contained herein are the rates proposed by South Anderson Water District for all customers, however the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that are higher or lower than the rates proposed in this notice. Any corporation, association, body public or person may request leave to intervene by motion within thirty (30) days after notice of the proposed rates change is given. A motion to intervene shall be in writing, shall be submitted to the Executive Director, Kentucky Public Service Commission, 211 Sower Boulevard, P. O. Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602, and shall set forth the grounds for the motion including the status and interest of the party. The application may be reviewed at the South Anderson Water District at 142 South Main St., Lawrenceburg, KY 40342 and the Kentucky Public Service Commission office listed above Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., or through the Commission's website at http://psc.ky.gov.

The proposed rates are scheduled to go into effect with the January 2017 meter readings which will be reflected on the first billing following February 1, 2017. The proposed rate increase of \$0.07/1,000 gallons or 0.74% on the average monthly bill will compensate for the higher wholesale purchase water rates allowed the Frankfort Plant Board by the Public Service Commission.

Meeting called to order at 6pm by Chairman Stevens, invocation by Commissioner Neat

Guest present but not on agenda included representatives of Kentucky American Water, Dotty Johnson and Kenny Roney. Although not on the agenda the board opened the floor to the representatives. They were just visiting water districts and attending board meetings to inform some of their employees as to the procedures involved. They also had a folder explaining the services that they offer to other water companies and informed the board that in the event of an emergency that they would be more than willing to help if needed. The board thanked them for the information and welcomed them to observe the meeting and the procedures involved.

The first item addressed by the board were the minutes from the previous meeting, after a brief review of the minutes the motion was made by Commissioner Baker to accept the minutes as prepared, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Neat- motion carried unanimously

Dudley Shryock then addressed the board with the monthly financial information. He distributed copies of the proposed 2017 budget for review and discussion. After reviewing the budget and discussing possible changes that needed to be made the motion was made by Commissioner Baker to accept the 2017 budget with the discussed changes, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Neat-motion carried unanimously

Ken Taylor, the districts engineer informed the board that the price increase from our supplier Frankfort Plant Board had taken effect earlier this month. This increased the cost to the district by 7 cents per 1000 gallons. Ken reminded the board that we did not adjust our rates to reflect the price increase from last year and that we needed to probably adjust our rates to include this additional amount. The board agreed with Mr. Taylors conclusion to implement the pass through rate increase. At the conclusion of the discussion, the motion was made by Commissioner Baker to prepare the "pass-through" increase and have our engineer complete the necessary paperwork and filings to adjust the districts current rates to reflect the suppliers increase, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Neat- motion carried unanimously

Then discussed was the matter of Carey Mill Road and the repairs that needed to be made as has been discussed in previous meetings. Chairman Stevens had discussed the situation with the previous County road foremen and had been informed that the county had never maintained this portion of the road during his tenure. Commissioner Baker had spoke to his brother who is employed by the Kentucky Department of Transportation and informed the board that he had stated that all counties have such maintenance issues in certain areas. The county road map that had been used as a reference by the county judge was on file with the state and listed county maintained roads, but changes in the area of maintenance (increases and decreases) were not reported. Shawn Cook, operations manager had collected bids from 3 contractors for repairs on Carey Mill Road. The companies and bid amounts are as follows: TK Bobcat \$4295, Kentucky Underground \$6680, and Bobby Hyatt Plumbing \$2800. It was discussed that we may need unit pricing for the gravel as it seems some additional gravel would need to be included to complete the repairs. The motion was then made by Commissioner Baker to accept the Hyatt Plumbing bid with the unit pricing amendment, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Neat-motion carried unanimously

Shawn Cook, operations manager informed the board that operations were normal at this time and the telemetry seemed to be working well. He stated that we had a couple of main line leaks, but otherwise, operations were normal. He also reminded the board of the upcoming Christmas dinner to be held at ADDIES in Versailles on December 8<sup>th</sup> @ 6pm. He also wanted to remind them of the upcoming PSC training on December 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> in Frankfort and the employee stipends to be handed out during the Christmas dinner.

At Mr. Cook's conclusion, the motion was made by Commissioner Baker to go into closed session to discuss employee matters, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Neat- motion carried unanimously/ closed session

Upon the boards return the motion was made by Commissioner Baker to return to regular session, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Neat- motion carried unanimously- back in regular session.

With no more business to discuss, the motion was made by Commissioner Neat to adjourn, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Baker- motion carried unanimously
