COMMISSION STAFF'S SECOND REQUEST FOR INFORMATION TO
KENERGY CORP.

Kenergy Corp. ("Kenergy"), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, is to file with the Commission the original in paper medium and an electronic version of the following information. The information requested herein is due within 14 days of this request. Responses to requests for information in paper medium shall be appropriately bound, tabbed, and indexed. Each response shall include the name of the witness responsible for responding to the questions related to the information provided.

Each response shall be answered under oath or, for representatives of a public or private corporation or a partnership or association or a governmental agency, be accompanied by a signed certification of the preparer or person supervising the preparation of the response on behalf of the entity that the response is true and accurate to the best of that person's knowledge, information, and belief formed after a reasonable inquiry.

Kenergy shall make timely amendment to any prior response if it obtains information which indicates that the response was incorrect when made or, though correct when made, is now incorrect in any material respect. For any request to which

Kenergy fails or refuses to furnish all or part of the requested information, it shall provide a written explanation of the specific grounds for its failure to completely and precisely respond.

Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. When the requested information has been previously provided in this proceeding in the requested format, reference may be made to the specific location of that information in responding to this request. When applicable, the requested information shall be separately provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations. When filing a document containing personal information, Kenergy shall, in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10), encrypt or redact the paper so that personal information cannot be read.

1. Refer to Kenergy's response to Staff's First Request for Information ("Staff's First Request"), Item 2.

a. Confirm that the threshold of 4-5 days estimated kWh usage at current rates is for residential kWh usage.

b. Provide the daily average residential kWh usage.

c. Explain whether Kenergy agrees with establishing a uniform threshold for all residential prepay participants.

2. Refer to Kenergy's response to Staff's First Request, Item 7.b.

a. Explain how the minimum purchase amount for new single-phase commercial prepay accounts will be established.

b. Provide the criteria for setting the balance-alert threshold for new single-phase commercial prepay participants.

c. Provide the daily average kWh usage for the single-phase commercial class.
