ORDER

On May 31, 2017, Madison County Utilities District ("Madison County") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.¹

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

Madison County purchases water from Richmond Utilities ("Richmond").

2. Richmond increased its wholesale rate to Madison County from \$2.35332 per 100 cubic feet to \$2.38391 per 100 cubic feet effective July 1, 2017.² Madison County proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective July 1, 2017, to reflect the increased cost of purchased water.

 Madison County proposes a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.04 per 100 cubic feet.

4. During the 12 months ended March 30, 2017, Madison County purchased 91,852,600 cubic feet of water from Richmond. During the same period, Madison County sold 77,236,799 cubic feet of water. The increase in the cost of purchased

water is \$28,097.71, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.04 per 100 cubic feet.

5. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.04 per 100 cubic feet, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

6. Madison County's rates proposed in the application should be approved.

7. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered by Madison County on and after July 1, 2017.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.04 per 100 cubic feet is approved.

2. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by Madison County on and after July 1, 2017.

3. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Madison County shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
