NOTICE

On September 7, 2017, the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC") accepted for filing Symsonia County Water District's ("Symsonia") application requesting to increase its revenue from sewer service by \$40,397, or 43.6 percent. After performing a review of Symsonia's application and financial records, the PSC Staff recommended that Symsonia be granted an increase in sewer service revenues of \$41,308, or approximately 42.5 percent. Pursuant to the PSC's Order of October 10, 2017, in Case No. 2017-00371, Symsonia requested that the PSC approve the PSC Staff recommended revenue requirement.

The amended sewer rates Symsonia requests would increase the monthly bill of a typical residential sewer customer using 4,000 gallons of water per month by \$15.03, from \$28.21 to \$43.24, or approximately 53.28 percent.
