ORDER

This matter arises from a review of Atmos Energy Corporation’s (Atmos) demand-side management (DSM) programs. By Order entered April 27, 2018, the Commission, among other things, denied the extension of Atmos’s DSM program offering customer rebates on high-efficiency appliances and programmable thermostats (Rebate DSM) beyond April 30, 2018. On May 21, 2018, the Commission granted rehearing of the April 27, 2018 Order and permitted Atmos to phase out the Rebate DSM program over 90 days. In a separate proceeding, Atmos confirmed that it terminated the Rebate DSM program and that rebates are not being offered or paid.<sup>1</sup>

The Commission, on its own motion, finds that the Rebate DSM program was terminated pursuant to the May 21, 2018 Order, there are no further issues to be reviewed in this case, and therefore this case should be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case is closed and removed from the Commission’s docket.
