ORDER

On November 6, 2017, Farmdale Water District ("Farmdale") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.¹

The Commission notes that in its 2016 Annual Report Farmdale reported a water loss of 39.1626 percent.² Farmdale's application provides updated purchases and sales information for a more current period than the 2016 Annual Report. Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:066(6)(3) states that for ratemaking purposes a utility's unaccounted-for water loss shall not exceed 15 percent of total water produced and purchased, excluding water consumed by a utility in its own operations. Based upon the updated information in the application and the percentage of other water consumed by the utility in its 2016 Annual Report,³ Farmdale's unaccounted-for water loss is determined to be 38.2546 percent for the updated period.⁴

Reduction of Farmdale's unaccounted-for water loss to 15 percent would result in an approximate \$156,728⁵ decrease to purchased water expense. Potentially, Farmdale is paying \$1.04 per 1,000 gallons sold, for expenses associated with unaccounted-for water loss in excess of the allowable 15 percent⁶ threshold.

The Commission is placing greater emphasis on monitoring utilities that consistently exceed the 15 percent unaccounted-for water loss threshold and strongly encourages Farmdale to pursue reasonable actions to reduce its unaccounted-for water loss. Failure by Farmdale to make significant progress towards reducing unaccountedfor water loss may cause the Commission to pursue additional action with the utility.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. Farmdale purchases water from the Frankfort Electric & Water Plant Board ("Frankfort").

Frankfort notified Farmdale that its wholesale rate would increase from \$2.45 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.55 per 1,000 gallons effective November 1, 2017.⁷
Farmdale proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective December 1, 2017 to reflect the increased cost of purchased water from Frankfort.

3. Farmdale proposed a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons.

4. During the 12 months ended August 31, 2017, Farmdale purchased 245,078,000 gallons of water from Frankfort. During the same period, Farmdale sold 151,274,000 gallons of water. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$24,507.80, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons.

5. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

6. Farmdale's proposed rates, as set forth in Appendix B to this Order, are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered by Farmdale on and after December 1, 2017.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.17 per 1,000 gallons is approved.

2. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by Farmdale on and after December 1, 2017.

3. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Farmdale shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
