ORDER

On December 14, 2017, Dexter-Almo Heights Water District ("Dexter-Almo") applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.¹

The Commission notes that in its 2016 Annual Report Dexter-Almo reported a water loss of 16.4455 percent.² Dexter-Almo's application provides updated purchases and sales information for a more current period than the 2016 Annual Report. Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:066(6)(3) states that for rate making purposes a utility's unaccounted-for water loss shall not exceed 15 percent of total water produced and purchased, excluding water consumed by a utility in its own operations. Based upon the updated information in the application and the percentage of other water consumed by the utility in its 2016 Annual Report,³ Dexter-Almo's unaccounted-for water loss is determined to be 16.7924 percent for the updated period.⁴

Reduction of Dexter-Almo's unaccounted-for water loss to 15 percent would result in an approximate \$2,339⁵ decrease to purchased water expense. Potentially, Dexter-Almo is paying \$0.06 per 1,000 gallons sold for expenses associated with unaccountedfor water loss in excess of the allowable 15 percent⁶ threshold.

The Commission is placing greater emphasis on monitoring utilities that consistently exceed the 15 percent unaccounted-for water loss threshold and strongly encourages Dexter-Almo to pursue reasonable actions to reduce its unaccounted-for water loss. Failure by Dexter-Almo to make significant progress towards reducing unaccounted-for water loss may cause the Commission to pursue additional action with the utility.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. Dexter-Almo purchases water from the Murray Municipal Utilities ("Murray").

2. Murray notified Dexter-Almo that its wholesale rate would increase from \$2.67 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.94 per 1,000 gallons effective January 1, 2018.⁷ Dexter-Almo proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective January 1, 2018, to reflect the increased cost of purchased water from Murray.

Dexter-Almo proposed a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.33 per 1,000 gallons.

4. During the 12 months ended October 31, 2017, Dexter-Almo purchased 44,387,000 gallons of water from Murray. During the same period, Dexter-Almo sold 36,840,200 gallons of water. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$11,984.49, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.33 per 1,000 gallons.

5. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.33 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

6. Dexter-Almo's proposed rates, as set forth in Appendix B to this Order, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered by Dexter-Almo on and after January 1, 2018.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.33 per 1,000 gallons is approved.

2. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by Dexter-Almo on and after January 1, 2018.

3. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Dexter-Almo shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
