On April 21, 2017, members of Commission Staff and representatives from Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power"), Sierra Club, the Attorney General, and Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers ("KIUC") participated in a telephonic informal conference. A list of the participants is attached. The purpose of the conference was to discuss Sierra Club's motion to amend the procedural schedule to provide for the filing of intervenor testimony and to schedule a hearing.

Sierra Club stated that, pursuant to the procedural schedule the Commission issued in this proceeding, it was requesting to file testimony as well for the Commission to schedule a hearing. Sierra Club requests that the deadline for filing of intervenor testimony be set for June 30, 2017.

Kentucky Power stated that, because the Commission initiated this proceeding, it would defer to the Commission's decision on whether to allow intervenor testimony. Kentucky Power did state that, in the event the Commission allowed for the filing of intervenor testimony, the procedural schedule should also be revised to include an opportunity for Kentucky Power to issue interrogatories on any intervenor testimony and possibly file rebuttal testimony. Kentucky Power also stated that it was not inclined to request a hearing in this matter.

KIUC stated that it would defer to the Commission's decision.

The Attorney General stated that it believed that the filing of intervenor testimony would prejudice no party.

Commission Staff stated that it would inform the Commission of Sierra Club's request and that the Commission would then address the motion through an Order.

Thereafter the conference adjourned.
