The purpose of this inspection is to evaluate the system and to determine whether The Gas Group is in compliance with federal and state safety requirements for the operation of a gas system. The inspection is NOT FOR THE PURPOSE OF SHUTTING DOWN THE GAS SYSTEM.

The inspection will consist of an on-site inspection of the gas system's infrastructure, which will include a review of a limited number of customer meter assemblies. If you would like Commission Staff to specifically check your meter for safety issues, please let us know as we will conduct a spot check and will not inspect every meter.

ORDER

On its own motion, the Commission finds that an inspection of the natural gas distribution system ("Pollitt System") that is the subject of this proceeding should be scheduled to better assist the Commission in reaching a decision in this matter. The Commission finds that Commission Staff should contact counsel for Defendant, Basil C. Pollitt ("Basil Pollitt"), within seven days of the date of this Order to schedule an inspection of the Pollitt System. The inspection of the Pollitt System, which includes a review of the Pollitt System records and the physical facilities, should be conducted on a mutually agreeable date no later than 30 days from the date of this Order. If Basil Pollitt does not respond to Commission Staff's request to schedule an inspection or does not commit to a mutually agreeable inspection date, then the inspection of the Pollitt System will commence on Monday, October 9, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. at 13517 Saddlecreek Drive,

Louisville, Kentucky, which is the principal office for the Pollitt System, and shall continue from day to day as necessary until completed.

At the August 9, 2017 hearing in this case, Basil Pollitt stated that Commission Staff have not contacted Mr. Pollitt to inspect the system since 2002.<sup>1</sup> Mr. Pollitt testified: "If we'd been approached by the Public Service Commission and asked, we would have gladly walked the line with them."<sup>2</sup> In response to his statement, Mr. Pollitt was informed that he would hear from the Inspections Staff thereafter.<sup>3</sup>

On Thursday, September 7, 2017, Commission Staff contacted counsel for Basil Pollitt to schedule an inspection. To date, neither counsel for Mr. Pollitt nor Mr. Pollitt has responded to the Commission Staff's request to schedule an inspection of the Pollitt System.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Commission Staff shall contact counsel for Basil Pollitt within seven days of the date of this Order to schedule an inspection of the Pollitt System.

2. The inspection, including system records, shall be conducted on a mutually agreeable date within the 30 days of the date of this Order, but absent agreement shall commence on Monday, October 9, 2017, and shall continue day to day as necessary until completed.

3. Within seven days of the date of this Order, Basil Pollitt shall notify the Commission in writing of the location at which the Pollitt System records will be made available for inspection.

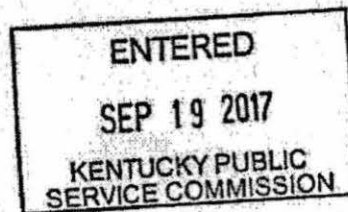


4. Commission Staff shall timely file into the record of this case an Inspection Report containing the results of the inspection.

5. Basil Pollitt's response to the Inspection Report, if any, shall be filed into the record of the case within ten days of the date the Inspection Report is filed pursuant to ordering paragraph 4.
