## ORDER

On June 12, 2017, Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power") filed an application requesting approval to change the layout and composition of its existing bills and to combine certain billing line items. That application was docketed as Case No. 2017-00231. By Order dated July 17, 2017, Case No. 2017-00231 was consolidated into the instant matter. By further Order dated August 16, 2017, the Commission granted Kentucky Power's motion for partial rehearing and amended the July 17, 2017 Order to provide that the Commission would issue an interlocutory decision on or before September 15, 2017, addressing Kentucky Power's request to change its billing format. The August 16, 2017 Order further stated that Kentucky Power's request to combine billing line items would be determined in the final Order of this matter.

Kentucky Power notes that the proposed bill redesign is in response to customers' feedback expressing frustration with the current bill format. According to Kentucky Power, the proposed redesign of the bill format would: enhance the presentation of the information displayed on the bill; give the bill a clean and more easily useable appearance; and make it easier for customers to identify and understand the information presented. Kentucky Power further indicates that the new design is less cluttered and utilizes color and graphics so that important information on the bill will be more easily identified.

Kentucky Power states that its proposed bill redesign is part of a broader effort by its parent company, American Electric Power Company, Inc. ("AEP"), to revise the bill formats of all of the AEP operating companies. Kentucky Power points out that because bills are prepared and printed centrally for all AEP operating companies, AEP intends to implement the conversion process to take place concurrently for all AEP operating companies in order to take advantage of the economies of scale to reduce cost and maximize efficiencies of the conversion process. The total cost of the AEP-wide bill redesign is approximately \$827,957.<sup>2</sup> Of that cost, Kentucky Power's portion would be \$33,000.<sup>3</sup> Kentucky Power states that the conversion process will take approximately eight to ten weeks to complete, with a target completion date of December 2017.

Having reviewed Kentucky Power's request to redesign its billing format, the evidentiary record relating to that request, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the

Commission finds that Kentucky Power's request is reasonable and should be approved. We note that the proposed changes as approved herein are only to the appearance of the bill. The substantive changes proposed relating to Kentucky Power's request to consolidate certain line items will be decided as part of the final Order in this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Kentucky Power's request to redesign its billing format is approved.
