## NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN WATER RATES

Notice is hereby given that Jackson County Water Association, a public utility furnishing water service within the Commonwealth of Kentucky, on or about the 26th day of April, 2017 pursuant to Kentucky Revised Statute 278.180 and KRS 278.023 and the Rules of the Public Service Commission of Kentucky filed its notice with the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("KPSC"), proposing to change its rates for the purpose of funding approximately 35,000 feet of water transmission main extensions and 19 miles of water line extensions and replacements to serve 92 additional customers from McKee to Sand Gap as well as related pumps and Morrill water storage and waterline improvements. The total cost of the project is approximately \$5,300,000, consisting of a U.S. Department of Agriculture (RD) loan of \$3,900,000, RD grant of \$905,000 and JCWA funds of \$488.00. The rates are proposed to become effective upon KPSC approval, which is expected within 30 days of this notice.
