Mr. Shipp,

Attached are the notice that will need to be submitted to Bullock Pen Water District, Corinth Water District, and the Commission and the tariff page that will need to be submitted to the Commission.

Please look over them and make sure everything is accurate. While I prepared the attached documents, it is ultimately the City's responsibility to ensure that the information filed with the Commission is accurate.

According to Corinth Water District, they also received a letter in March indicating that the rate Williamstown charges it was going to increase by 3%. In preparing these documents, I am assuming the rate to Corinth is also going to be \$3.19 per 1,000 gallons.

Given that the Williamstown August billing cycle covers water used from June 15 to July 15, I have reflected an effective date of June 15, 2017 on the attached documents.

Therefore, the attached documents will need to be received by the Commission no later than May 16. They can be submitted to the Commission via e-mail at psc.tariffs@ky.gov. It would probably be best to include a copy of the March 28, 2017 letter sent to both Bullock Pen Water District and Corinth Water District notifying them of the increase.

The billing cycle for August for both districts are invoiced a month behind. The billing cycle for August is covered by June 15, 2017 (beginning reading) through July 15, 2017 (ending reading).
