That Applicant, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.023, seeks (i) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN"), permitting Applicant to construct a waterworks improvement project (the "Project"); (ii) an Order approving increased water rates; and (iii) approval of the proposed plan of financing said Project.
- 4. That the Project originally consisted of Contract 1 only. The Applicant bid the Project on May 4, 2017 and the bid specifications allowed for two pipe materials, PVC and Ductile Iron. The bids came in significantly lower than expected and the Applicant choose to use Ductile Iron pipe due to its increased longevity. In order to preserve the USDA, Rural Development ("RD") grant awarded to the Applicant as part of the funding for the Project, which grant would be deobligated by RD due to the large cost underrun, the Applicant, in cooperation with the Engineers, has developed additions to the scope of the Project which will be bid at a later date as Contract 2. The Applicant hereby formally requests that the Commission keep this Case open until such time
