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SUPPLEMENTAL FILING AND EXPLANATION

The Applicant, Grayson County Water District (the "District"), by Counsel, files this Supplemental Filing and Explanation in accordance with the Staff's request as a result of an Informal Teleconference held on July 10, 2017.

Request 1. The Commission Staff requested an explanation regarding the difference in the total cost of the new building project (the "Project") (\$1,295,506) and the financing (\$950,000) listed in the USDA, Rural Development (USDA") Letter of Conditions filed as Exhibit "B" to the original Application.

Response: The District has been leasing space for it's operations from Warren Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("WRECC") and during the term of said lease, the District constructed a warehouse facility on WRECC's property to assist the District in it's operations. The District is in the process of constructing a new facility and has agreed with WRECC to terminate the lease upon completion of the District's new facility. As part of this termination, the District sold it's

warehouse to WRECC for a price of \$348,000, which sale has been finalized. The District is using the sale proceeds to fund the difference between the cost of the new facility and the USDA loan and grant financing.

Request 2. The Commission Staff noted that the date of the USDA Letter of Conditions is December 21, 2012 and expressed concern whether or not USDA is still honoring it's commitment to fund the Project.

Response: The USDA letter of concurrence in bid award was filed as Exhibit "C" to the original Application and provides evidence that USDA is still committed to funding the Project. USDA has issued a letter stating that the funding is still available to the District. A copy of said USDA letter is attached hereto.
