## MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC"), by counsel, and moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") for an Order extending the deadline by which EKPC must file its responses to the requests for information contained the Appendix of the Commission's Order entered herein on August 30, 2017. Specifically, EKPC requests that it be allowed an additional 7 (seven) days (*i.e.*, until Wednesday, September 20, 2017) to file its direct responses.

In support of this Motion, EKPC states that additional time is necessary in order to adequately review, compile and confirm the extensive information and voluminous documentation EKPC must provide pursuant to the Commission's August 30, 2017 Order. While EKPC endeavors to provide its responses to the Commission's requests for information as soon as practicable, many employees who will be responsible for obtaining the requested information will be on vacation the week of September 4, 2017 since this is a holiday week and with the current deadline, the responses would be due on Wednesday, September 13, 2017. Since some employees will not be returning to work from vacation until Monday, September 11, 2017, and the fact that EKPC's board meeting is the week of September 11, 2017, the relatively brief extension of time prayed for herein is reasonable and will not result in prejudice or undue delay.

WHEREFORE, for good cause shown, EKPC respectfully requests an Order from the Commission extending to September 20, 2017, the deadline by which EKPC must file responses to the requests for information propounded in the August 30, 2017 Order.
