RE: Case No. 2017-00309: Application of Cawood Water District For an Alternative Rate Adjustment

On October 11, 2017, Commission Staff ("Staff") held a telephonic informal conference ("IC") with representatives from Cawood Water District ("Cawood Water"). The sign-in sheet of the participants is attached.

The purpose of the IC was to allow Staff to inquire as to Cawood Water's proposed rates. Particularly, Staff sought to question Cawood Water regarding the request to unify its various rates as the Commission had not previously approved unification of rates in this manner.

Cawood Water responded that it had concluded that Staff did not approve of the proposal to unify rates. Cawood Water stated that, when it filed the application, it believed that the Commission would approve a unified rate.

Staff informed Cawood Water that a unified rate would require a rate design change, and the Commission would not approve a change in rate design without a cost of service study. Staff presented some scenarios to Cawood Water in which Cawood Water could meet its revenue requirement without unifying its rates.

Staff suggested that Cawood Water wait until the Staff Report was issued to decide if it wanted to amend its application to seek an across the board increases in rates or other increase other than seeking a unified rate. Staff and Cawood Water also discussed proposed increases to non-recurring charges.

Thereafter the conference adjourned.
