**MOTION FOR USE OF ELECTRONIC FILING PROCEDURES**

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, Muhlenberg County Water District (“Muhlenberg District”) moves that the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) require the use of electronic filing procedures in this proceeding.

In support of its motion, Muhlenberg District states:

1. The Commission’s Rules of Procedure permits an applicant to elect the use of electronic filing procedures in a proceeding.<sup>1</sup> While those Rules suggest a preference for an applicant to make its election prior to the submission of its initial papers initiating a proceeding, those Rules do not prohibit a party in a complaint proceeding from requesting the use of electronic filing procedures after the proceeding has been initiated. The Commission has previously granted a

motion to process a case under the electronic filing procedures after the proceeding had begun.<sup>2</sup>

2. Requiring the use of electronic filing procedures at this early stage in the proceedings will not prejudice any potential party, the public, or the Commission. It will reduce the cost of these proceedings to all potential parties by reducing the number of copies of any document that must be produced in paper medium, ensure a more rapid and timely distribution of documents to potential parties and the Commission, and allow for greater transparency and public awareness by enabling the documents' immediate posting to the Commission's website.

3. Counsel for Muhlenberg District spoke to counsel for Mr. Hill regarding this motion on November 27, 2017. Counsel for Mr. Hill indicates that he and his client have no objection to the use of electronic filing procedures in this proceeding.

4. Muhlenberg District and its authorized representatives have registered with the Commission's E-Filing System and are authorized to make electronic filings with the Commission.

5. Muhlenberg District and its authorized representatives possess the facilities to receive electronic mail transmissions.

6. Muhlenberg District's authorized representatives and their e-mail addresses for electronic delivery of notices of filing of documents are set forth below.


