In accordance with the Tariff dated August 7, 2017, the city of Barbourville increased its wholesale rate to Knox County Utility Commission by \$3.41 per 1,000 gallons. This retail rate adjustment will be in effect for bills delivered to customers on or after September 1, 2017.
