RE: Informal Conference of April 23, 2018

Pursuant to a Staff Notice issued on April 23, 2018, a telephonic informal conference ("IC") was conducted in this case on April 23, 2018. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was to reconcile the difference in the revenue from present rates in the unadjusted test year shown in the Supplemental Direct Testimony of John Wolfram, Revised Exhibit JW-2, page 1 of 38, as compared to the revenue shown in the consumption analysis as provided in the Direct Testimony of John Wolfram, Exhibit JW-9, page 1 of 9. As provided in Revised Exhibit JW-2 page 1 of 38, revenue from present rates for the unadjusted test year reflects \$22,470,741. However, Exhibit JW-9, page 1 of 9, the present revenue was provided as \$22,538,001, or a difference of \$67,240. Big Sandy's retained consultant, Mr. John Wolfram, explained that in Revised Exhibit JW-2 there was a number "hard coded" in the spreadsheet that should have been revised. This revision accounted for the majority of the difference. The balance of the difference was the reconciliation of booked versus calculated billing as shown on page 8 of Exhibit JW-9. With these two corrections, the revenue from present rates in the unadjusted test year as shown of revised Exhibit JW-2, page 1 of 38, will match the Consumption Analysis.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
