That Applicant, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.023, seeks (i) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN"), permitting Applicant to construct a system improvement project (the "Project"); (ii) an Order approving increased water and sewer rates; and (iii) approval of the proposed plan of financing said Project.
- 4. That the Project consists of the installation of (i) approximately 2,000 linear feet of 3 inch water main and associated appurtenances; (ii) upgrades and replacements of 3 pump stations; (iii) repainting of an existing water storage tank; and (iv) installation of tank circulation facilities for 3 tanks.
