Pursuant to a Commission Staff ("Staff") Notice, a telephonic informal conference ("IC") was conducted at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky on November 13, 2017. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was to discuss Delta Natural Gas Company's ("Delta") supplemental responses to item 4 of the Commission's First Request for Information filed on November 8, 2017 and November 9, 2017.

During the IC, Staff requested that Delta provide a calculation showing that the method of refinancing being proposed in this case, which would be at no cost, is more beneficial than refinancing at a lower interest rate. John Brown of Delta gave a brief description of the loan that is being refinanced, noting that, when originally issued, Delta received a competitive interest rate and incurred few fees due to the fact that there was a prepayment penalty clause. Mr. Brown indicated that Delta's calculations showed that it could refinance at a lower interest rate and pay approximately \$4.9 million less in interest over the life of the loan; however, he indicated those savings would be offset by an approximately \$10 million prepayment penalty.

Delta indicated that it would file the information requested by Staff no later than November 14, 2017.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
