

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION OF THE U.S. 60 Water District, AUTHORIZING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW RATES, SUBMITTING NEW RATES TO THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING A REPRESENTATIVE TO SIGN ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the Frankfort Electric and Water Plant Board has raised the wholesale cost of water and

WHEREAS, the Public Service Commission has approved the rate increase; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to adjust its rates to its customers to reflect the wholesale rate increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the U.S. 60 Water District as follows:

SECTION 1. That the District hereby accepts the rate awarded by the Public Service Commission and approves the raising of rates by a like amount to its customers.

SECTION 2. That William Eggen is hereby authorized, directed and empowered by the District to execute the necessary documents, and to otherwise act on behalf of the District to implement the changed rates.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
