Informal Conference of January 30, 2019

Pursuant to Commission Staff's (Staff) Notice issued on January 23, 2019, an informal conference (IC) was conducted on January 30, 2019. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The purpose of the IC was to discuss Elkhorn Water District's (Elkhorn District) response to Staff's recommendations that were contained in its report issued December 3, 2018, for Elkhorn District's Alternative Rate Filing. Elkhorn District specifically questioned Staff's recommended treatment of the post-test year engineering fees paid and recorded as a test-year expense.

Elkhorn District explained that Staff failed to review the cost of purchased water cases incurred in previous years and to include amortization of these prior costs in its recommended revenue requirement. Staff described the ratemaking principals of retroactive ratemaking and matching. Staff further explained that including the amortization of those prior non-recurring costs in the test-year expenses would violate such ratemaking principals.

Elkhorn District agreed with Staff's representation of the principals and accepted Staff's recommended revenue requirement. Elkhorn District agreed to submit in writing that it was amending its application to reflect Staff's recommended revenue requirement and rates.

There being no further discussion, the IC was then adjourned.
