TESTIMONY OF ASHLEY SANDERS MANAGER OSP ENGINEERING - KY WINDSTREAM

- 1 Q. Please state your name, position, and business address.
- 2 A. My name is Ashley L. Sanders. I am Manager OSP Engineering KY for Windstream.¹
- 3 My business address is 130 West New Circle Road Suite 170, Lexington, KY 40505.
- 4 Q. Please describe your educational and professional background.
- 5 A. I received a B.A. in Kinesiology from Transylvania University in 1999. I've been in the
- field of telecom for 18 years now. I started with BellSouth in 2000 (later bought by AT&T)
- as an OSP Engineer for 3 years and then ran the in-house construction crew of linemen and
- 8 splicers for 4 years. I had 12 CWA Union techs reporting to me at this time as Manager,
- 9 OSP Construction. I left AT&T in 2007 to come to Windstream to get back into the OSP
- Engineering side of the house. I worked again as an OSP Engineer for 8 years. Then,
- moved in to Management as OSP Engineering Supervisor from 2015 2018. I was
- promoted to Manager of OSP Engineering over the whole state of KY in April of 2018. I
- have 1 OSP Engineering Supervisor & 15 OSP Engineers reporting to me currently
- throughout the State.
- 15 Q. Have you or those you supervise witnessed any problems stemming from the
- attachment of CMN to poles belonging to Windstream in the Lexington area?
- 17 A. Yes, we have. We have seen several problems.
- First, we have seen some dangerous practices by CMN contractors doing the work
- of attaching lines to poles. In Exhibit 1, you can see that the contractor is actually standing
- on a cable. Exhibit 1, WIN3225-3226. This is very dangerous and is not workmanlike
- 21 completion of this job.

Second, we have had issues with CMN contractors damaging Windstream facilities
and even cutting Windstream lines. Discussions of this are shown in Exhibit 2, WIN7659-
7664. A list of damages caused by CMN contractors is also attached at Exhibit 3,
WIN0001.

Q. CMN has expressed that it would be willing to pay for Windstream to outsource review of engineering? Why has Windstream refused this offer?

A.

Windstream Engineering's main function is to engineer new builds, help reengineer existing infrastructure to maintain Windstream's network, and oversee Windstream contractors in performing the construction of these builds and maintenance projects.

As a secondary function, Windstream's Engineers coordinate and manage make ready design and construction for Parties attaching to Windstream's poles. This means managing contractors as they perform the work necessary to allow *other* providers to attach facilities to Windstream poles. This also means inspecting the attachments of other providers to ensure all safety and engineering requirements are met. These requirements are set by the Federal Communications Commission, the Kentucky Public Service Commission, and the National Electric Safety Code. Not following these rules may result in significant fines, or worse, the injury of a member of the public. There are literally millions of utility poles in Kentucky and accidents can and do occur. For this reason, it is imperative that Windstream use the utmost caution in reviewing and approving the attachments that go on its poles. Therefore, Windstream must rely on its own internal engineers to ensure compliance.

An increase in the number of applications submitted creates a greater burden on Windstream internally. All surveys and applications must be reviewed by Windstream to

ensure CMN is not illegally attaching to poles or placing attachments to poles in an unsafe or improper manner. While Windstream can have contractors hired to preform processing and construction, an increase of applications and make ready work means there is an increased need for review. Windstream cannot outsource the review and quality control part of the make ready process.

Windstream is certainly not willing to outsource this review for CMN given its recent behavior. For example, last week, a Windstream employee spotted a CMN employee standing on a Windstream cable while suspended in the air working on the CMN line while wearing metal gaff hooks. Exhibit 2, WIN3225. It would be a gross violation of safety regulations to stand on the cable, it is extraordinarily dangerous to do so while wearing metal gaff hooks. Not only is it a safety violation to stand on the cables, but CMN has not yet paid the make ready estimate for attachment to this pole.

Q. Does this conclude your testimony?

Just to update everyone Metro net has cut two more cables today. One at 248 Catera Trace a 200 pair cable in the East and one on Darlington Circle in the Lakeside was a 400 pair, poissible dead cable though. The other thing that has come up is there are numerous buried drops that have been cut during this process as well. Metronet contractor is putting wire nuts on the pairs and then taping it up with electrical tape and then putting back in the ground and covering it up. We know of 4-5 drops, but do not know how many they have done that we do not know about. Without having the Ranger seal closure on the splice, it will sooner or later go bad and will need replaced. I am not quite sure what steps should be taken either by Metronet to let us know a drop has been cut or to prevent them from splicing them together the way they are.
