On October 16, 2018, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") first learned that the Complainant filed the document styled "Motion to Deny the Request to Dismiss" in the above-referenced case. LG&E did not receive a service copy of the original filing, apparently made on September 10, 2018, which was well after the August 27<sup>th</sup> deadline contained in the Commission's August 13<sup>th</sup> Order.

LG&E has now reviewed the Complainant's filing; and after reviewing the Complainant's account again in light of this new filing, LG&E disputes all of the factual assertions in the new filing. Moreover, LG&E notes that these factual allegations have no bearing on the legal basis on which LG&E has moved to dismiss the Complaint.

Therefore, LG&E respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Motion to Dismiss for all the reasons stated in the original Motion filed on July 20.
