The Kentucky River Authority, at its April 9th board meeting, voted to adjust the Tier II water withdrawal fee set forth in administrative regulation 420 KAR 1:050. **Beginning July 1, 2018 the new Tier II rate will be \$0.22 per 1,000 gallons** of water withdrawn. (Currently this rate is \$0.13 per 1,000 gallons). The Tier I rate will remain unchanged.
