Due to a rate increase from Kentucky River Authority, notice is hereby given that Jessamine County Water District No.1 has filed an application for a Purchased Water Adjustment with the Kentucky Public Service Commission for the purpose of adjusting its water rate. Customer rates will increase .16 cents per 1000 gallons used. The proposed change will be effective for service rendered on or after **July 10, 2018.**

Due to an increase in the Kentucky River Authority Tier II withdrawal fee, the Nicholasville Water Department ("Nicholasville Water") plans to file with the Public Service Commission, no later than June 1, 2018, a proposed rate schedule, to be effective July 1, 2018, to increase the volumetric charge for wholesale water service to Jessamine County Water District No. 1 and Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District as follows:



The Kentucky River Authority, at its April 9th board meeting, voted to adjust the Tier II water withdrawal fee set forth in administrative regulation 420 KAR 1:050. **Beginning July 1, 2018 the new Tier II rate will be \$0.22 per 1,000 gallons** of water withdrawn. (Currently this rate is \$0.13 per 1,000 gallons). The Tier I rate will remain unchanged. This rate increase is necessary to fund the debt service required for the capital improvements at Dam 10 on the Kentucky River. If you have any questions, please call our office at (502) 564-2866.
