### **Notice Of Intent**

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:120, Section 1, KRS 278.020, and all other applicable statutory provisions and regulations, Kentucky Power Company gives notice of its intent to file on or before August 15, 2018 an application seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct the proposed Enterprise Park Economic and Area Improvements Project located in Pike and Floyd counties, Kentucky. The Enterprise Park Economic and Area Improvements Project will involve:

- (a) the construction of approximately five miles of new double circuit 138 kV transmission line ("Kewanee 138 kV Extension") from the existing Sprigg Beaver Creek 138 kV Transmission Line;
  - (b) the construction of the proposed Kewanee Substation; and
  - (c) the retirement and removal of the Fords Branch Substation.

The proposed Kewanee Substation will replace the existing Fords Branch Substation.

The Kewanee 138 kV Extension will be constructed within a new 100-foot right of way and will

directly serve the Kentucky Enterprise Industrial Park and associated businesses. (Kentucky Power may be required to obtain a wider right-of-way in those areas where doing so is required by the safe and efficient operation of the proposed transmission line.) Attached is a map showing the general route of the proposed Kewanee 138 kV Extension. The Kewanee 138 kV Extension and the proposed Kewanee Substation will also improve the distribution reliability in the area.


