NOTICE, APPLICATION, AND MOTION FOR DEVIATION

- 1. Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers") on behalf of itself and
 two of its three member distribution cooperative-owners, Jackson Purchase Energy
 Corporation ("Jackson Purchase") and Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative
 Corporation ("Meade County") files this Notice, Application, and Motion for
- Deviation ("<u>Application</u>") pursuant to KRS 278.040, KRS 278.180, KRS 278.220, 807
- 12 KAR 5:001 Section 14, and 807 KAR 5:011 to provide statutory notice to the
- 13 Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission" or "PSC") of the withdrawal or
- revision of certain existing energy efficiency/demand-side management ("DSM")
- 15 programs and tariffs, and to seek an order from the Commission authorizing Big
- 16 Rivers to establish a regulatory liability to defer certain revenues related to the
- 17 withdrawal of the DSM programs and tariffs. Big Rivers' third member distribution
- 18 cooperative-owner, Kenergy Corp. ("Kenergy") made a separate DSM filing with the
- 19 Commission on or about June 14, 2018, withdrawing all of its existing DSM
- 20 programs. (Jackson Purchase, Kenergy, and Meade County are collectively referred

- 1 to herein as the "Members." Jackson Purchase and Meade County are collectively
- 2 referred to herein as the "Participating Members.") In support of this Application,
- 3 Big Rivers states as follows:

4 Introduction

- 5 2. Big Rivers is a rural electric cooperative corporation organized
- 6 pursuant to KRS Chapter 279; its full name is Big Rivers Electric Corporation; its
- 7 mailing address is P.O. Box 24, Henderson, Kentucky 42419-0024; and its address
- 8 for electronic mail service is regulatory@bigrivers.com. 807 KAR 5:001 Section
- 9 14(1). Big Rivers was incorporated in the Commonwealth of Kentucky on June 14,
- 10 1961, and hereby attests that it is currently in good standing in Kentucky. 807
- 11 KAR 5:001 Section 14(2).
- 12 3. Jackson Purchase is a rural electric cooperative corporation organized
- pursuant to KRS Chapter 279; its full name is Jackson Purchase Energy
- 14 Corporation; its mailing address is P.O. Box 4030, Paducah, Kentucky 42002; and
- its address for electronic mail service for this proceeding is
- dennic.cannon@jpenergy.com. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 14(1). Jackson Purchase was
- incorporated in the Commonwealth of Kentucky on June 12, 1937, and hereby
- 18 attests that it is currently in good standing in Kentucky. 807 KAR 5:001 Section
- 19 14(2).
- 4. Meade County is a rural electric cooperative corporation organized
- 21 pursuant to KRS Chapter 279; its full name is Meade County Rural Electric
- 22 Cooperative Corporation; its mailing address is P.O. Box 489, Brandenburg,

- 1 Kentucky 40105-0189; and its address for electronic mail service for this proceeding
- 2 is mlittrel@mcrecc.com. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 14(1). Meade County was
- 3 incorporated in the Commonwealth of Kentucky on June 4, 1937, and hereby attests
- 4 that it is currently in good standing in Kentucky. 807 KAR 5:001 Section 14(2).
- 5. Big Rivers owns generating assets and purchases, transmits and sells
- 6 electricity at wholesale. Its principal purpose is to provide the wholesale electricity
- 7 requirements of its three Members. The Members in turn provide retail electric
- 8 service to approximately 116,000 retail members/consumers located in 22 western
- 9 Kentucky counties: Ballard, Breckenridge, Caldwell, Carlisle, Crittenden, Daviess,
- 10 Graves, Grayson, Hancock, Hardin, Henderson, Hopkins, Livingston, Lyon,
- 11 McCracken, McLean, Marshall, Meade, Muhlenberg, Ohio, Union and Webster.

12 DSM Tariff Changes

- 6. In its December 21, 2017, order in PSC Case No. 2017-00278, the
- 14 Commission found that "Big Rivers and its Members should review their DSM
- 15 programs to determine which programs should continue and which programs should
- be discontinued and make a filing no later than June 30, 2018, reflecting any
- 17 changes."1
- 7. As explained in more detail in the Direct Testimony of Russell L.
- 19 Pogue, attached hereto as Exhibit A, Big Rivers and its Members have determined
- to withdraw all of their existing DSM programs. The Total Resource Cost ("TRC")

- 1 test for seven² of the existing DSM programs no longer exceed 1.0, and these
- 2 programs and the corresponding tariffs are being withdrawn by Big Rivers and the
- 3 Participating Members immediately.
- 4 8. The four other existing DSM programs have a TRC greater than one.
- 5 Big Rivers and the Participating Members are phasing these programs out over the
- 6 remainder of 2018 and 2019 to allow commercial and industrial customers who have
- 7 made investments in DSM/energy efficiency projects in anticipation of receiving
- 8 incentives under the programs to complete those projects. Jackson Purchase and
- 9 Meade County are proposing revised tariff sheets for these four programs to include
- 10 "up to" language that matches the corresponding Big Rivers tariff sheets, which will
- provide them flexibility to reduce the available incentives to assist with the gradual
- 12 phase out of the programs.
- 9. Big Rivers' revised tariff sheets eliminating the seven DSM programs
- with TRC tests less than 1.0 are attached hereto as Exhibit C; Jackson Purchase's
- revised tariff sheets eliminating eight DSM programs and inserting the "up to"
- language in the other programs are attached hereto as Exhibit G; and Meade
- 17 County's revised tariffs eliminating the seven DSM programs and inserting the "up
- to" language in the other programs are attached hereto as Exhibit K. Once the four
- 19 remaining programs are phased out next year, Big Rivers, Jackson Purchase, and
- 20 Meade County will file revised tariff sheets eliminating those programs.

- 1 10. Big Rivers and the Participating Members' revised tariff sheets are being filed pursuant to KRS 278.180(1) and 807 KAR 5:011 Section 6.
- Redline mark-ups of the proposed tariff sheets showing the changes
- 4 from the Big Rivers, Jackson Purchase, and Meade County tariffs currently on file
- 5 with the Commission are attached hereto as Exhibit D. H, and L, respectively.
- 6 12. On this date, Big Rivers is providing notice of its proposed tariff
- 7 changes to each of its three customers (the Members) by mailing them a copy of this
- 8 Application, including a copy of the proposed tariff sheets. 807 KAR 5:011 Section
- 9 8(2)(a). Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011 Section 8(4):

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- 10 a. The revised tariff sheets are expected to be filed with the
 11 Commission on July 6, 2018, and the proposed effective date is
 12 August 6, 2018.
 - b. Attached hereto as Exhibit E is a schedule showing the present rates and proposed rates for each customer class to which the proposed rates will apply and the amount of the change requested in both dollar amounts and percentage change for each customer classification to which the proposed rate change will apply. Note that the only Big Rivers customer class to which the DSM tariffs apply is Big Rivers' Rural class and that the rates under the DSM tariff sheets are incentives and not charges. Also, because the incentives paid under the DSM tariff sheets are not dependent on usage, Big Rivers and its Members are not including in their

customer notices the amount of the average usage and the effect
upon the average bill for each customer class to which the proposed
rate change will apply.

- c. A person may examine this tariff filing and any other documents
 Big Rivers has filed with the Public Service Commission at the
 offices of Big Rivers located at 201 Third Street, Henderson,
 Kentucky 42420, and on the Big Rivers website at
 http://www.bigrivers.com/regulatory-affairs/. A person may
 examine this tariff filing at the Commission's offices located at 211
 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky, Monday through Friday,
 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., or through the Commission's website at
 http://psc.ky.gov. Comments regarding this tariff filing may be
 submitted to the Public Service Commission through its website or
 by mail to Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615,
 Frankfort, Kentucky 40602.
 - d. The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Big Rivers but the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice. A person may submit a timely written request for intervention to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602, establishing the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party. If the Commission does not

- receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of
- the mailing of this notice, the Commission may take final action on
- 3 the tariff filing.
- 4 13. An affidavit from an authorized Big Rivers representative verifying the
- 5 contents of the notice, that notice was mailed to all customers, and the date of the
- 6 mailing is attached hereto as Exhibit B. 807 KAR 5:011 Section 8(3)(a).
- 7 14. Jackson Purchase anticipates providing notice to its retail
- 8 members/customers of its proposed tariff changes by publishing notice in
- 9 newspapers of general circulation in August 2018 pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011
- 10 Section 8(2)(b). A copy of Jackson Purchase's affidavit regarding this notice is
- attached as Exhibit F; a copy of Jackson Purchase's notice is attached hereto as
- 12 Exhibit I.
- 13 15. Meade anticipates providing notice to its retail members/customers of
- its proposed tariff changes in the August 2018 edition of Kentucky Living magazine,
- a trade publication which will be mailed to all of its retail members/customers
- around. 807 KAR 5:011 Section 8(2)(b). A copy of Meade County's affidavit
- 17 regarding this notice is attached as Exhibit J; a copy of Meade's notice is attached
- 18 hereto as Exhibit M.
- 19 16. After Jackson Purchase and Meade's notices are published, they will
- 20 file affidavits with the Commission verifying the contents of their notices; that the
- 21 notices were published in a newspaper or trade publication; and the dates of the
- newspapers' publication or trade publication's mailing. 807 KAR 5:011 Section 8(3).

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expenditures."3

2	17. Although Jackson Purchase and Meade have also been communicating
3	with their retail members/consumers about the phase out of their DSM programs,
4	they could not provide formal notice of their tariff changes until Big Rivers and the
5	Members determined which programs would be terminated immediately and which
6	programs would be phased out over time. Because of the timing of that decision,
7	the decision of Big Rivers and its Members to make a joint filing, and the delay
8	associated with publishing notices, Jackson Purchase and Meade's formal notices of
9	their tariff changes will not be published until after this Application is filed with
10	the Commission. Further, because the incentives paid under the existing DSM
11	programs are not charges and are not dependent on usage, not all of the notice
12	requirements in 807 KAR 5:011 Section 8 are applicable. As such, Big Rivers and
13	the Participating Members request a deviation pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011 Section
14	15 from any notice requirements with which their notices do not comply.
15	Request for Regulatory Liability
16	18. In its December 21, 2017, order in P.S.C. Case No. 2017-00278, the
17	Commission directed, "No later than June 30, 2018, Big Rivers shall submit a plan
18	to earmark the annual difference between its DSM expenditures for the programs

that remain and the amount included in Big Rivers' base rates for DSM

- 1 19. As explained in more detail in the Direct Testimony of Russell L.
- 2 Pogue, Big Rivers' current Rural base rate demand charge includes a DSM
- 3 component of \$0.195 per kW, which was approved in Big Rivers' most recent rate
- 4 case (Case No. 2013-00199) based on forecasted annual DSM spending of
- 5 approximately \$1 million.
- 6 20. As Mr. Pogue explains in his testimony, Big Rivers is not only
- 7 withdrawing its existing DSM programs, but it is also implementing a new Energy
- 8 Efficiency Education initiative and a new Low-Income Weatherization initiative.
- 9 Even with the new initiatives, as a result of the withdrawal and phase out of the
- 10 existing DSM programs, Big Rivers will likely spend less on DSM in future years
- than the amount it recovers through rates (the "DSM Savings"). Big Rivers has
- already spent most of the \$1 million DSM budget for 2018 and does not anticipate
- that there will be any material reduction in DSM spending in 2018. However, in
- 2019, Big Rivers anticipates that it will spend about \$250,000 on the remaining
- 15 DSM programs, as well as \$250,000 on Energy Efficiency Education and Low-
- 16 Income Weatherization, resulting in DSM Savings in 2019 of approximately
- 17 \$500,000. After the remaining DSM programs are phased out in 2019, Big Rivers
- anticipates that going forward, its DSM spending will be limited to the \$250,000
- 19 annual spend on Energy Efficiency Education and Low-Income Weatherization.
- resulting in annual DSM Savings of approximately \$750,000 beginning in 2020. Big
- 21 Rivers requests that the Commission grant it the authority to defer the DSM
- 22 Savings in a regulatory liability

As Mr. Pogue further explains, in Big Rivers' most recent rate case 21. 1 2 (Case No. 2013-00199), the Commission required Big Rivers to defer through a regulatory asset the annual depreciation expense for Big Rivers' Wilson generating 3 station. In Big Rivers' next rate case, Big Rivers will seek to recover the amount in 4 the Wilson regulatory asset through rates. The annual depreciation expense on 5 6 Wilson is approximately \$20 million. In order to reduce the amount in the Wilson regulatory asset that Big Rivers will need to recover through its rates in its next 7 rate case, Big Rivers proposes that the revenues it defers in the DSM regulatory 8 liability be offset against the Wilson regulatory asset. Big Rivers would then seek 9 recovery in its next rate case of only the net amount remaining in the Wilson 10 regulatory asset. 11 22. To establish a regulatory liability to defer recognition of the DSM 12 13 Savings, Big Rivers needs the approval of both the Rural Utilities Service ("RUS") and the Commission. RUS' letter authorizing Big Rivers to establish the regulatory 14 liability is attached hereto as Exhibit N. Big Rivers requests that the Commission 15 likewise authorize Big Rivers to establish a regulatory liability. The authority of 16

5	I.	INTRODUCTION
6	Q.	Please state your name, business address and occupation.
7	A.	My name is Russell L. Pogue, and my business address is Big Rivers
8		Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers"), 201 Third Street, Henderson, Kentucky,
9		42420. I am the Manager, Member Relations for Big Rivers. I report to
0		Mark J. Eacret, Big Rivers' Vice President Energy Services.
1		
12	Q.	Please summarize your education and professional experience.
13	A.	I have Bachelor of Science degree in Engineering Management/Mechanical
14		Engineering from the Missouri Institute of Science and Technology. I am a
15		Certified Energy Manager (C.E.M.), Certified Business Energy Professional
16		(CBEP), a Certified Demand Side Manager (CDSM), and a member of the
17		Association of Energy Engineers. Prior to joining Big Rivers, I designed
18		and implemented Demand-Side Management ("DSM") programs at
19		Associated Electric Cooperative in Springfield, Missouri, and was a Senior
20		Project Engineer at the Mid-America Manufacturing Technology Center in
21		Rolla, Missouri.
22		
23	Q.	Please summarize your duties at Big Rivers.
24	A.	I am responsible for Big Rivers' Member relations. Among other things, I
25		work with Big Rivers' Members on the administration, development, and
26		documentation of their respective Demand-Side Management/Energy
27		Efficiency ("DSM/EE") programs. This includes periodic meetings of the
28		joint Big Rivers/Members DSM/EE Working Group which has oversight of
99		these programs. I also am responsible for a major component of Big Rivers

1	integrated Resource Plan ("IRP") including the IRP's DSM/EE Potentia
2	Study Report and its related appendices.

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Q. Have you previously testified before this Commission?

5 Α. Yes. I testified on behalf of one of Big Rivers' Members, Meade County 6 Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Meade County") in one of Meade 7 County's general rate proceedings, Case No. 2010-00222. I have answered 8 data requests in Big Rivers' DSM/EE tariff filings - Case Nos. 2012-00142, 9 2013-00099, 2015-00118, and 2017-00278. I was also a witness responding 10 to data requests in Big Rivers' most recent IRP filings - Case Nos. 2010-11 00443, 2014-00166, and 2017-00387. I also sponsored direct testimony and 12 answered data requests in Big Rivers' declaratory request related to 13 construction of seven solar arrays. Finally, I either responded to, or drafted 14 responses to, certain DSM/EE-related data requests in Big Rivers' two most 15 recent general rate proceedings – Case Nos. 2012-00535 and 2013-00199.

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Q. For whom are you testifying in this proceeding?

18 I am testifying on behalf of Big Rivers and two of its three distribution Α. 19 cooperative member-owners. Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation 20 ("Jackson Purchase") and Meade County. Collectively, Jackson Purchase and Meade County are Big Rivers' "Participating Members." Big Rivers' 21 other Member is Kenergy Corp. ("Kenergy"), who made a separate filing on 22 23 or about June 14, 2018, to withdraw all of its existing DSM programs. 24 Collectively, Jackson Purchase, Kenergy, and Meade County are Big Rivers 25 "Members" or "Member-Owners."

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Q. What is the purpose of your testimony in this proceeding?

1	A.	The purpose of my testimony is to explain and support the changes which
2		Big Rivers and the Participating Members are making to their respective
3		DSM programs currently on file with the Commission, and to describe the
4		Energy Use Education and Low-Income Weatherization Assistance that Big
5		Rivers and its Members plan to implement. As part of these DSM program
6		changes, I will describe the process for ending, or winding down, the DSM
7		programs. Finally, I will outline how Big Rivers proposes to address the
8		differences between the current amount for DSM included in Big Rivers
9		base rates and the amount Big Rivers will spend on DSM, retail member
10		education, and low income weatherization going forward.
11		
12		
13	II.	BIG RIVERS DSM PROGRAMS
14	Q.	What DSM programs does Big Rivers propose to discontinue?
15	A.	Big Rivers is proposing to discontinue all of its existing DSM programs. Big
16		Rivers proposes to discontinue the following DSM programs immediately:
17		1. DSM-01 - High Efficiency Lighting Replacement,
18		2. DSM-02 - ENERGY STAR® Clothes Washer Replacement Incentive,
19		3. DSM-03 - ENERGY STAR® Refrigerator Replacement Incentive,
20		4. DSM-06 - Touchstone Energy® New Home,
21		5. DSM-07 - Residential/Commercial HVAC & Refrigeration Tune-Up,
22		6. DSM-09 - Commercial/Industrial General Energy Efficiency, and
23		7. DSM-13 - Residential Weatherization A La Carte.

Q. Why is Big Rivers proposing to immediately discontinue these DSM
 programs?

24

27 A. The Total Resource Cost ("TRC") tests for each of these programs no longer 28 exceed 1.0. As such, these programs are no longer cost effective.

- Q. What is Big Rivers proposing with regard to its other DSM programs?
- 4 A. Big Rivers proposes to phase the following DSM programs out over time:
- 5 1. DSM-04 Residential High Efficiency Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning ("HVAC"),
- DSM-08 Commercial / Industrial High Efficiency Lighting Replacement Incentive,
- 9 3. DSM-11 Commercial High Efficiency Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning ("HVAC"), and
- 11 4. DSM-12 High Efficiency Outdoor Lighting.
- The individual TRC tests for each of these programs exceeds 1.0

- 14 Q. Why is Big Rivers proposing to phase these programs out over time?
- 16 A. Big Rivers and its Members discussed our options to comply with Ordering 17 Paragraph No. 3 of the Commission's Order dated December 21, 2017, in 18 Case No. 2017-00378. Since the Participating Members had promoted their respective DSM programs and, therefore, their respective retail members 19 were aware of them, the Participating Members were concerned about 20 21 immediately ending programs where retail members may have begun to 22 make investments in reliance on the incentives, especially for commercial 23 and industrial projects where the lead time can be substantial. We 24 concurred that those programs which were no longer cost-effective, i.e., had 25 a TRC of equal to or less than 1.0, should be withdrawn immediately. The remaining DSM programs with a TRC equal to or greater than 1.0, would 26 27 be phased out overtime. Big Rivers and the Participating Members' current 28 target for doing so is explained below.

- 10 A. Yes. A table showing the results of the program analysis, including Net

communication will allow the Member-Owners and Big Rivers to continue
providing the retail members with straightforward information on which to
make safe and beneficial energy-use decisions.

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10 Q. Please describe how the Energy Use Education will operate.

11 A. Big Rivers will coordinate with, and distribute funds to, its Members to
12 assist with the process of communication. Big Rivers will assist the
13 Members with the development of the information the Members will
14 provide. Each Member will determine the actual communication methods
15 to use, e.g., website, bill inserts, newsletters, annual meetings, et. al.

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Q. You also mentioned Low-Income Weatherization Assistance. Please describe this program?

19 A. Big Rivers will work with Community Action Agencies within its Members'
20 respective service territories to provide weatherization assistance for
21 weatherization-related measures that otherwise would not be completed
22 due to restrictions of other funding on health and safety measures, or a lack
23 of available funding.

- Q. Please describe how Low-Income Weatherization Assistance will
 operate.
- 27 A. Big Rivers will work directly with the Community Action Agencies and the 28 Kentucky Housing Corporation to monitor opportunities to support

1		weatherization on behalf of, or in conjunction with, the Members as
2		appropriate. Big Rivers will provide funds to the Community Action
3		Agencies with the requirements that (i) the Agencies can only use the funds
4		to support weatherization measures for low-income households who are
5		served by one of Big Rivers' Members, and (ii) the funds should only support
6		weatherization measures that would not otherwise be completed.
7		•
8	Q.	How much does Big Rivers anticipate it will spend on these
9		initiatives?
10	A.	Big Rivers and its Members anticipate spending approximately \$250,000
11		annually to fund the Energy Use Education and Low-Income
12		Weatherization initiatives.
13		
14		
15	VII.	REGULATORY LIABILITY
16	Q.	What is the purpose of the regulatory liability Big Rivers is
17		requesting in this filing?
18	A.	Big Rivers' base rates include a DSM component. Big Rivers' current Rural
19		base rate demand charge of \$13.8050 per kW includes a DSM component of
20		\$0.195 per kW, which was approved in Big Rivers' most recent rate case
21		(Case No. 2013-00199) based on forecasted annual DSM spending of
22		approximately \$1.0 million. Big Rivers' current Industrial rates do not
23		include a DSM component, since customers served by those Industrial rates
24		do not participate in the DSM program.

Big Rivers anticipates that going forward, its spending on the DSM

programs that are being phased out, and the spending on the two new

initiatives, will be less than the amounts it collects through base rates. For

2018, Big Rivers has already spent most of its \$1.0 million DSM budget and

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does not anticipate that there will be any material reduction in DSM spending in 2018, even after the withdrawal of the seven DSM programs. In 2019, Big Rivers anticipates that it will spend about \$250,000 on the remaining DSM programs, as well as \$250,000 on Energy Use Education and Low-Income Weatherization Assistance. After the remaining DSM programs are phased out in 2019, Big Rivers anticipates that, going forward, its spending will be limited to the \$250,000 annual spend on Energy Use Education and Low-Income Weatherization Assistance.

Because Big Rivers anticipates that its future spending on DSM will be less than the amount it collects through base rates for DSM, Big Rivers is requesting to defer in a regulatory liability the recognition of the DSM revenues that it collects through base rates that exceed the amount Big Rivers spends on DSM and the two new initiatives each year.

Further, in Big Rivers' most recent rate case (Case No. 2013-00199), the Commission required Big Rivers to defer through a regulatory liability the annual depreciation expense for Big Rivers' Wilson generating station. In Big Rivers' next rate case, Big Rivers will seek to recover the amount in the Wilson regulatory asset through rates. The annual depreciation expense on Wilson is approximately \$20 million. In order to reduce the amount in the Wilson regulatory asset that Big Rivers will need to recover through its rates in its next rate case, Big Rivers proposes to offset the Wilson regulatory asset with the revenues it defers in the DSM regulatory liability. Big Rivers would then seek recovery in its next rate case of the net amount remaining in these two accounts.

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

On July 6, 2018, Jackson Purchase Energy Corporation ("Jackson Purchase"), in a Joint Filing with Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers") and Meade County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Meade County") filed proposed changes to its tariff sheets for its Demand-Side Management programs only with the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission"). In 2012, Meade County RECC launched its energy efficiency education program, Smart Savings, to help our members save on energy dollars and become more energy efficient. This program encountered great success, giving away over \$1.5 million in energy efficiency rebates and helping customers save nearly 7 million kWh since the inception of the program.

However, due to the abundance of energy efficiency products in the marketplace along with the energy reduction goals we achieved during the past 6 years, Meade County RECC plans to discontinue a portion of the less cost-effective programs at year-end.

We will continue to honor the program in its entirety, until the end of 2018.

Starting in 2019, we will only offer the rebates that yield the greatest longterm financial rewards, which are **High Efficiency Heating & Air Conditioning** (HVAC) and the **High Efficiency Lighting** for residential and commercial applications.

In response to a letter from Ms. DeAnna M. Speed, dated May 23, 2018, we have reviewed the information submitted regarding Big Rivers Electric Corporation's (Big Rivers) establishment of a regulatory liability. Big Rivers is requesting approval to defer the recognition of certain revenues it expects to refund as a result of modifying its offering of Demand Side Management programs.

All of the required information was submitted in the letter; therefore, the Rural Utilities Service's (RUS) approval to implement the plan is given. It should be noted, however, that our approval is based upon the understanding that the Commission authorizes these deferrals. If the Commission does not allow these deferrals, the entire deferred amount must be recognized into income immediately. It is also expected that when the regulatory liability is amortized it will be recognized against Account 447.1 – Sales for Resale – RUS Borrowers.

RUS also requires that your auditor verify the adequacy of the funds being segregated to support any revenue deferral amount and to make a disclosure in the audited financial statements each year of the deferral and amortization period.
