Dear Ms. Pinson:

The Marion County Water District respectfully requests that the Commission allow for an adjustment to our rates in accordance with 807 KAR 5:068 Purchased Water Adjustment clause.

Per order of the Commission in Case No. 2017-00417, the Lebanon Water Works Company will increase meter service charges by \$5.88 per month and decrease their volumetric wholesale rate by \$0.45 per 100 cubic feet (\$0.6016 per 1000 gallons). These rate changes were effective July 12, 2018. The result of these changes is a \$273,949.95 decrease in annual supply cost for the District. This translates into \$0.70 per 1000 gallons of water sold to our customers. Therefore, we propose to decrease our rates by that amount.

An application requesting the proposed rates was filed with the Kentucky Public Service Commission on July 23, 2018 to decrease rates as follows:

As noted above, based on the decreased cost of water from the Lebanon Water Works Company all rates will decrease by \$0.70 per 1,000 gallons. The monthly bill for an average residential customer using 5,343 gallons of water each month will decrease from 44.74 to \$41.00. This is a decrease of \$3.74 or 8.36%.

The charges/rates contained in this notice are the charges/rates proposed by the Marion County Water District. However, the Public Service Commission may order charges/rates to be charged that differ from these proposed charges/rates. Such action may result in charges/rates for consumers other than the charges/rates detailed in this notice.
