In accordance with the requirements of the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC") as set out in 807 KAR 5:076, Section 5, notice is hereby given to the customers of the North McLean County Water District (the "District") of a change in water rates for users of the District's water system. The changes in water rates are required due to the District's 2017 annual audit loss. North McLean County Water District will file an application on July 27, 2018 with the Public Service Commission.
