

# NOTICE OF ELECTION OF USE OF ELECTRONIC FILING PROCEDURES

(Complete All Shaded Areas and Check Applicable Boxes)

In accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, <u>Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc.</u> gives notice of its intent to file an application for <u>an adjustment of the Natural Gas Rates, etc....</u> with the Public Service Commission no later than September 7, 2018 and to use the electronic filing procedures set forth in that regulation.

<u>Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc.</u> further states that:
