## MOTION TO SUBMIT CASE FOR ADJUDICATION ON THE ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC"), by counsel, and hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") to submit the above-styled case for a decision based upon the existing record and without the need for a hearing, respectfully stating as follows:

On October 16, 2018, the Commission issued an Order establishing a procedural schedule which allowed for the filing of direct testimony, data requests and a deadline for motions to intervene in the case. The only intervenor in the case is the Office of the Kentucky Attorney General ("AG"). Both EKPC and the AG have provided all of the requested information.

Since the remainder of the procedural schedule only allows for rebuttal testimony of EKPC and EKPC does not plan to file any rebuttal testimony, EKPC believes the administrative record is complete and it would be appropriate for the Commission to make a ruling based upon the record. EKPC respectfully waives the right to a hearing and requests a decision from the

Commission based upon the existing record. Following consultation, EKPC understands that the AG does not have an objection to this motion.

WHEREFORE, EKPC moves the Commission to submit the case on the existing administrative record.
