ORDER

On October 15, 2018, Kentucky Utilities Company (KU) filed a notice of satisfaction of the complaint filed by Stephen W. Peyton and moved that this case be dismissed. In his complaint, Mr. Peyton disputed charges on his bill arising from his tenant's alleged unauthorized energy use and alleged tampering with a meter at a rental home owned by Mr. Peyton. In the notice of satisfaction, KU explained that it refunded the disputed charge by issuing a credit to Mr. Peyton's account for \$303.71. KU stated that Mr. Peyton was agreeable to the resolution of the matter.

Based upon the notice of satisfaction, the case record, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission thus finds that KU's motion to dismiss should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KU's motion to dismiss is granted.
2. This matter is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
