("EKPC"), by counsel, and hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") to submit the above-styled case for a decision based upon the existing record and without the need for a hearing, respectfully stating as follows:


On September 10, 2018, the Commission issued an Order establishing a procedural schedule which allowed for the filing of direct testimony, data requests and a deadline for motions to intervene in the case. EKPC has provided all of the requested information and there have been no motions for intervention filed in this case.

Since the remainder of the procedural schedule only applies to intervenors, and there are no intervenors in this case, EKPC believes the administrative record is complete and it would be appropriate for the Commission to make a ruling based upon the record. EKPC respectfully waives the right to a hearing and requests a decision from the Commission based upon the existing record.

WHEREFORE, EKPC moves the Commission to submit the case on the existing administrative record.
