The Public Service Commission acknowledges receipt of your public comment letter regarding your concerns as to the application for approval to construct a wireless communications facility in the case referenced above. Your comment has been placed in the official case file of this proceeding. The Commission will carefully analyze your comment as part of its review before rendering its final decision in this matter.

By this letter, we are forwarding a copy of your comment to the Applicant for a response. Commission Staff requests the Applicant to submit a written response to the comment, with a copy to the Commission, within 15 days of the date of this letter.

It may be helpful for you to know that federal law limits state authority, specifically that of the Commission, in the review of this matter. For example, Section 704 of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 prohibits this Commission from regulating the placement of wireless facilities based on environmental effects of the radio frequency emissions to the extent that facilities comply with Federal Communications Commission regulations. Section 704 also prohibits a state or local government from prohibiting telecommunications facilities construction if such denial will have the effect of prohibiting service. In addition, this Commission is required by statute to ensure that utility service, including telecommunications service, is adequate and reliable.



Project Background/Objective

The proposed coverage cell site will provide mobile coverage near Meldrum, Kentucky in central Bell County. The Rocky Face cell site will fill a large coverage hole along Hwy 25E between Pineville and Middlesboro. This site in combination with the Pineville will provide connection. coverage from Pineville to the Virginia State line.

**Property Tested** 

The Asher 1 property located at 36-42-34.6N, 83-40-57.6W and 2015ft AMSL was tested on 03-01-01.

The Asher 2 property located at 36-42-56.4N, 83-40-55.2W and 2150ft AMSL was tested on 03-01-01. The Bianchi 1 property located at 36-40-46.5N, 83-41-22.2W and 1525ft AMSL was tested on 03-01-01. The Bianchi 2 property located at 36-40-45.9N, 83-41-15.4W and 1434ft AMSL was tested on 03-01-01. The Rocky Face property located at 36-41-3.3N, 83-40-36.8W and 2040ft AMSL was tested on 03-01-01.

#### Test Configuration

The property was tested using a test transmitter and 3 dB gain Omni antenna at the stated heights AGL, 40watta ERP.

### Analysis/Conclusions

When the TX test channel is integrated into the best server plot, the test channel becomes dominant throughout this area. The test location provides line of sight coverage into Meldrum and along HWY 25E between Pineville and Middlesboro, resulting in at least -95dBm coverage. The handoff boundary between the Pineville and Middlesboro sites will occur in strong coverage. The order of preference is as follows:

Priority L) Based on these results, the Asher 2 site is APPROVED at a 2250' AMSL rad, center.

Priority 2.) Based on these results, the Asher 1 site is APPROVED at a 2250' AMSL rad. center.

Priority 3.) Based on these results, the Bianchi 1 site is APPROVED at a 1775' AMSL rad. conter.

Princity 4.) Based on these results, the Bianchi 2 site is APPROVED at a 1775' AMSL rad, center.

This afte will not be subject to contour extension negotiations due to the previously negotiated contour agreements. This cell will be an omni configuration.

Middlesboro airport is located approximately 5 NM Southwest to the closest approved property.
