

CUSTOMER NOTICE

On October 9, 2018, the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC") accepted for filing Muhlenberg County Water District #3's ("District") application requesting an increase in its annual revenue from retail water service by \$220,918 or 20.7 percent. After performing a review of the District's application and financial records, the PSC Staff recommended that the District be granted an increase in annual water revenues of \$278,673, or approximately 26.1 percent. Pursuant to the PSC's Order of November 19, 2018, in Case No. 2018-00346, the District requested that the PSC approve the PSC Staff-recommended revenue requirement and that the District be allowed to implement the revised rates as follows:

The amended retail water rates the District requests would increase the monthly bill of a typical residential customer using 4,000 gallons of water per month from \$28.65 to \$36.15. This is an increase of \$7.50 or 26.2%.
