That Applicant, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.023, seeks (i) a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, permitting Applicant to construct a waterworks improvement project (the "Project"); (ii) an Order approving increased water rates; and (iii) approval of the proposed plan of financing said Project.

4. That the Project consists of (i) repainting and rehab of three storage tanks; the Diamond Ridge, Gregoryville No.2, and Route 7 tanks, (ii) installation of water lines on the following roads: Hardy Branch, Hamilton Branch A & B, Bells Trace/Knotty Poplar, Parker Hollow Road, Dehart Road, Ison Creek, Glen Lawson off KY 504, Cave Branch, Sutton Road, Carter Ford Road, and KY 409, (iii) construction of a new office, (iv) purchase of a portable generator that can be moved to any of the pump stations in the system during emergency power outages, (v) upgrade of the Diamond Ridge pump station, (vi) installation of a new PRV station at Huff Run Road, (vii) upgrade the WTP SCADA system, (viii) construction of a new 250,000 gallon elevated storage tank
