RE: Rate Increase

Dear Mr. Eggen:

The Commission met on Monday October 15, 2018, and recommended a Rate Increase of approximately 5%, for water and sewer utilities to the Shelbyville City Council.

The Shelbyville City Council will hold its first reading on Thursday, November 15, 2018, and its second reading on Thursday, December 6, 2018.

The rate increase for these Wholesale Purchasers will be effective for water used on and after December 19, 2018, for billing dated February 1, 2019

The Water Districts meters are normally read on the 19th of each month.

Your proposed rate increase is from \$2.11 to \$2.22/1,000 gal, or an increase of approximately 5% (5.21%)

Enclosed is a copy of the proposed rate ordinance to be submitted to the City Council, a copy of the PSC "Form for Filing Rate Schedules", and the formal "NOTICE" as the PSC requires.

This information has been mailed to the PSC.

NOTICE

The Shelbyville Municipal Water & Sewer Commission (SMW&SC) is providing notice that on October 15, 2018, a proposed increase in water rates was approved, including wholesale rates, and recommended these changes to the City Council. On October 30, 2018, the SMWSC filed with the Public Service Commission the wholesale rates it charges North Shelby Water Company and U.S.60 Water District of Shelby and Franklin Counties. These rates are effective for water service rendered on and after December 19, 2018. The proposed rates are as follows:

Water flowing through the meter(s) before the effective date will be charged at the current rates while water is flowing through the meter(s) on and after the effective date will be charged at the proposed rates.

The Rates contained in this NOTICE are the rates proposed by the "SMW&SC", however the Public Service Commission may order rates that differ from the proposed rates.

Intervention may be requested by submitting a timely written request for intervention by mail to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602. The request for intervention must establish the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party.

If the Public Service Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the providing of this notice, the Public Service Commission may take final action on the filing.

SECTION 2. That William Eggen is hereby authorized, directed and empowered by the District to execute the necessary documents, and to otherwise act on behalf of the District to implement the changed rates.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.


