On January 23, 2019, the Kentucky Public Service Commission directed its Staff to review the proposed rates and submit a written report of its findings and recommendations regarding Graves District's proposed rate adjustment. On June 10, 2019, Public Service Commission Staff issued

For a residential customer with an average monthly usage of 4,000 gallons of water, the Public Service Commission Staff's proposed rates would result in a monthly bill of \$27.48 for water service.

On August 6, 2019, the Public Service Commission authorized Graves District to begin charging the Commission Staff-recommended rates for service provided on and after that date.

In its report, the Public Service Commission Staff also recommended that Graves District be authorized to assess a Monthly Water Loss Detection and Repair Surcharge of \$3.20 to each customer for three (3) years. The proposed surcharge was intended to produce additional revenues of \$549,969. The proceeds of this surcharge were to be used solely for water loss leak detection and repair expenses that Graves District identified in its Application.

On August 6, 2019, the Public Service Commission held a hearing at its offices in Frankfort, Kentucky, on Graves District's water loss detection and repair plan. The video transcript of this hearing may be viewed at <https://youtu.be/ZxvAEt5aiU4>. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Public Service Commission allowed Graves District additional time to submit a more detailed plan of the costs of its water loss detection and repair plan and the method through which the cost of this plan would be recovered through a monthly surcharge on Graves District's customers.

On August 19, 2019, Graves District submitted a detailed plan to the Public Service Commission. In this plan, Graves District proposes to assess a monthly surcharge of \$5.00 to each customer for six (6) years. The proposed surcharge would produce total revenues of \$1,721,160 which would only be used for the water loss detection and repair measures identified in the plan and approved by the Public Service Commission.



For a residential customer with an average monthly usage of 4,000 gallons of water, the Public Service Commission Staff's proposed rates would result in a monthly bill of \$27.48 for water service.

On August 6, 2019, the Public Service Commission authorized Graves District to begin charging the Commission Staff-recommended rates for service provided on and after that date. In its report, the Public Service Commission Staff also recommended that Graves District be authorized to assess a Monthly Water Loss Detection and Repair Surcharge of \$3.20 to each customer for three (3) years. The proposed surcharge was intended to produce additional revenues of \$549,945. The proceeds of this surcharge were to be used solely for water loss detection and repair expenses that Graves District identified in its Application.

On August 6, 2019, the Public Service Commission held a hearing at its offices in Frankfort, Kentucky, on Graves District's water loss detection and repair plan. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Public Service Commission allowed Graves District additional time to submit a more detailed plan of the costs of its water loss detection and repair plan and the method through which the cost of this plan would be recovered through a monthly surcharge on Graves District's customers.

On August 19, 2019, Graves District submitted a detailed plan to the Public Service Commission. In this plan, Graves District proposes to assess a monthly surcharge of \$5.00 to each customer for six (6) years. The proposed surcharge would produce total revenues of \$1,721,160 which would only be used for the water loss detection and repair measures identified in the plan and approved by the Public Service Commission.
