## ORDER

A hearing was held before the Kentucky Public Service Commission on September 27, 2019, at its offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky, concerning the allegation that Jonathan Hylton violated KRS 367.4911 (1)(a) on August 09, 2018, at approximately 12:55 p.m., at 94 Fraley Road, Salt Lick, Kentucky, when he conducted excavation activities within the approximate location of an underground facility using mechanized equipment and thereby caused damage to an underground gas service line owned and operated by Delta Natural Gas Company, Inc., which was used to serve the public.

The testimony presented at the hearing has convinced the Commission that the case against Jonathan Hylton should be dismissed with prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. This case be and it is Hereby Dismissed with Prejudice.

THIS IS A FINAL AND APPEALABLE ORDER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION.

An application for a rehearing may be filed with the Commission within 20 days after service of this Order as provided by KRS 278.400. Any appeal of this Order must be filed with the Franklin Circuit Court within 30 days after service of this Order or within 20 days after an application for rehearing has been denied by failure of the Commission to act or, within 20 days after service of the final Order, as set out in KRS 278.410.
