ORDER

On June 13, 2019, South Hopkins Water District (South Hopkins District) applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment (PWA) procedure.¹

The Commission notes that in its 2017 Annual Report South Hopkins District reported a water loss of 17.6850 percent.² South Hopkins District's application provides updated purchases and sales information for a more current period than the 2017 Annual Report. Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 6(3), states that for ratemaking purposes a utility's water loss shall not exceed 15 percent of the total water produced and purchased, excluding water consumed by a utility in its own operations. Based upon the updated information in the application and the percentage of other water consumed by the utility in its 2017 Annual Report,³ South Hopkins District's water loss is determined to be 30.6256 percent for the updated period.⁴

Reduction of South Hopkins District's water loss to 15 percent would result in an approximate \$151,492⁵ decrease to purchased water expense. Potentially, South Hopkins District is paying \$0.53 per 1,000 gallons sold for expenses associated with water loss in excess of the allowable 15 percent⁶ threshold.

The Commission is placing greater emphasis on monitoring utilities that consistently exceed the 15 percent water loss threshold and strongly encourages South Hopkins District to pursue reasonable actions to reduce its water loss. Failure by South Hopkins District to make significant progress towards reducing water loss may cause the Commission to pursue additional action with the utility.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. South Hopkins District purchases water from the city of Madisonville (Madisonville) and the city of Dawson Springs (Dawson Springs).

2. Dawson Springs notified South Hopkins District that its wholesale rate would increase from \$1.8702 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.1600 per 1,000 gallons effective July 1, 2019.⁷ South Hopkins District proposes to increase the water rates to its

customers effective July 1, 2019, to reflect the increased cost of purchased water from Dawson Springs.

South Hopkins District proposed a purchased water adjustment factor of
 \$0.31 per 1,000 gallons.

4. South Hopkins District filed a letter on June 27, 2019, stating that the application incorrectly stated the amount of the total gallons sold on the Purchased Adjustment Form. The correct amount of total gallons sold is 284,244,942.

5. During the 12 months ended April 30, 2019, South Hopkins District purchased 5,516,000 gallons of water from Madisonville and 437,307,050 gallons of water from Dawson Springs. During the same period, South Hopkins District sold 284,244,942 gallons of water. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$126,731.59 resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.45 per 1,000 gallons.

6. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.45 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

 South Hopkins District's proposed rates were calculated using incorrect information and should be denied.

8. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for water service rendered by South Hopkins District on and after July 1, 2019.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. South Hopkins District's proposed rates are denied.

2. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.45 per 1,000 gallons is approved.


3. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by South Hopkins District on and after July 1, 2019.
