ORDER

On July 2, 2019, Whitley County Water District No. 1 (Whitley District #1) applied for approval to adjust its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure.¹

The Commission notes that in its 2017 Annual Report, Whitley District #1 reported a water loss of 23.8095 percent.² Whitley District #1's application provides updated purchases and sales information for a more current period than the 2017 Annual Report. Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 6(3), states that for ratemaking purposes a utility's unaccounted-for water loss shall not exceed 15 percent of total water produced and purchased, excluding water consumed by a utility in its own operations. Based upon the updated information in the application and the percentage of other water consumed by the utility in its 2017 Annual Report,³ Whitley District #1's unaccounted-for water loss is determined to be 28.40 percent for the updated period.⁴

Reduction of Whitley District #1's unaccounted-for water loss to 15 percent would result in an approximate \$87,107⁵ decrease to purchased water expense. Potentially, Whitley District #1 is paying \$0.52 per 1,000 gallons sold for expenses associated with unaccounted-for water loss in excess of the allowable 15 percent⁶ threshold.

The Commission is placing greater emphasis on monitoring utilities that consistently exceed the 15 percent unaccounted-for water loss threshold and strongly encourages Whitley District #1 to pursue reasonable actions to reduce its unaccounted-for water loss. Failure by Whitley District #1 to make significant progress towards reducing unaccounted-for water loss may cause the Commission to pursue additional action with the utility.

The Commission, having reviewed the record and being sufficiently advised, finds that:

- 1. Whitley District #1 purchases water from the city of Jellico, Tennessee (Jellico), the city of Corbin (Corbin), the city of Williamsburg (Williamsburg), and McCreary County Water District (McCreary District).
- 2. Jellico notified Whitley District #1 that its wholesale rate would increase from \$3.00 per 1,000 gallons to \$3.50 per 1,000 gallons, effective July 1, 2019. Whitley District #1 proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective August 1, 2019, to reflect the increased cost of purchased water from Jellico.

- Whitley District #1 proposed a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.16
 per 1,000 gallons in its application.
- 4. During the 12 months ended March 31, 2019, Whitley District #1 purchased 51,952,200 gallons of water from Jellico; 155,957,000 gallons of water from Corbin; 36,829,000 gallons of water from Williamsburg; and 9,496,100 gallons of water from McCreary District, with a total of 254,234,300 gallons of water purchased from all sources.⁷ During the same period, Whitley District #1 sold 166,022,800 gallons of water. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$25,976.10, resulting in a purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.16 per 1,000 gallons.
- The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.16 per 1,000 gallons, as calculated in Appendix A to this Order, is fair, just and reasonable, and should be approved.
 - 6. Whitley District #1's proposed rates should be approved.
- 7. The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order, are fair, just and reasonable, and should be approved for water service rendered by Whitley District #1 on and after August 1, 2019.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The purchased water adjustment factor of \$0.16 per 1,000 gallons is approved.
 - 2. The rates proposed by Whitley District #1 are approved.
- The rates as set forth in Appendix B to this Order are approved for water service rendered by Whitley District #1 on and after August 1, 2019.

- 4. Within 20 days of the date of entry of this Order, Whitley District #1 shall file with the Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets showing the rates approved herein.
- 5. Within 30 days of the date of entry of this Order, Whitley District #1 shall file with the Commission Proof of Notice pursuant to 807 KAR 5:068, Section 5(3).
- Any document filed pursuant to ordering paragraph 5 of this Order shall reference the number of this case and shall be retained in the post case correspondence file.
 - 7. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
